Safety Information Sheet

Walk Behind Blower

WARNING!!

- Wear approved safety glasses when operating this equipment. The operation of any powered machine can result in objects being thrown by high-speed rotating parts.
- Wear work gloves, sturdy footwear, and hearing protection when operating this machine.
- Exercise extreme caution on slopes and avoid excessively steep slopes.
- Do not blow any burning or smoldering materials such as cigars, cigarettes, ashes or cinders.
- Do not blow areas that have been recently treated with fertilizers, pesticides, or herbicides.
- Keep in mind that the operator or user is responsible for accidents or hazards occurring to other people or their property.
- Never pick up or carry equipment while the engine is running.
- Keep the area of operation clear of all persons, particularly small children, and pets. Keep bystanders at least 25 feet away from the area of operation.
- Do not run the engine in an enclosed area.
- Do not operate this equipment near buildings, windows, or air conditioners.
- Do not allow hands or any other part of the body or clothing inside the vacuum inlet.
- Do not start engine or operate this equipment with any safety guards or housing removed.
- Operate the machine in daylight or good artificial light.

TO START ENGINE:

1. Make sure fuel shut off valve is OPEN.
2. Push choke lever to CHOKE position.
3. Move throttle to FAST. Operate engine with throttle in FAST.
4. Grasp rope handle. Pull slowly until resistance is felt, then pull rapidly to start engine.
5. Let engine warm up. Slowly adjust toward RUN position.

TO STOP ENGINE:

CAUTION: Do not stop engine by moving choke control to CHOKE. Backfire, fire or engine damage could occur.

1. Move throttle to SLOW, then to STOP.
2. Close fuel shut off valve. (straight up and down).
